

Kriti Sanon Recalls Breaking Down During Bhediya Promotions: 'I Started Crying'



Hollywood star Kriti Sanon recently shared her experience with the intense burnout that actors face while promoting multiple films back-to-back. Reflecting on the demanding schedule, Kriti revealed that she had a breakdown during the promotions for her film Bhediya, a time when she was juggling several other projects.

Speaking to Ranveer Allahbadia, Kriti said, "Promotions can be very tiring. I almost had a breakdown when I was promoting Bhediya. That year, I had two or three other releases, so I had already done promotions two or three times before. While promoting Bhediya, we were traveling to different cities back-to-back. We even took a charter at night, jumping cities, sleeping at night, going to another city, doing interviews, and repeating the same things again and again. I wished I could have my answers on a tape recorder. Like, dial 1 for this question and 2 for another. By the end of it, both Varun [Dhawan] and I had memorized each other's answers."

Recounting her breaking point, Kriti said, "On the last day of promotions, I was supposed to appear on a reality show. I was getting ready in my vanity van, and during some conversation, I started crying. I said, 'I'm very tired; I can't do this. I'm exhausted.' Everyone around me froze. It affects your mental health."

Kriti also emphasized that while she loves acting, the additional pressures of the film industry, such as constant traveling and back-to-back events, often take a toll. She admitted that stress sometimes pushes her to rebel against the routine. "Sometimes, I become rebellious. Like, I'll refuse to attend an award show. Once, I told my stylist I wouldn't go for a photoshoot, and she said I'd have to buy the outfit if I didn't go. So, I bought it. Bad mein jaake fatka laga mujhe but... (Later, I realized it made a dent in my pocket, but...)"

Beyond her acting commitments, Kriti has also ventured into production. She recently appeared in Do Patti, a Netflix release where she played a double role for the first time and made her debut as a producer. The film marked a new chapter in her career, showcasing her versatility both in front of and behind the camera.

Kalki 2 Shoot Delayed Due To Deepika Padukone? Actress Prioritising Daughter Dua, To Resume Work Later

the news of their daughter's arrival through a lovely post on social media. In November, the couple revealed that they have named her Dua, and explained its significance. "Dua Padukone Singh 'Dua': meaning a Prayer. Because She is the Answer to our Prayers. Our hearts are filled with Love & Gratitude. Deepika & Ranveer," they wrote.

Meanwhile, talking about Kalki 2898 AD, the film released on June 27 this year and also stars Prabhas, Kamal Haasan and Amitabh Bachchan in the lead. The film gained an overwhelming response from the audience and earned over Rs 1000 crore at the worldwide box office.
